

What you need to bring **Pesticides PA1 and PA6**

Candidates should bring the following to the training and assessment:

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Face Shield
- Coverall (suitable for pesticides use) - preferably the disposable type. These should be Type 5/6. Type 3 or 4 accepted.
- Wellington boots
- Nitrile Gloves (not disposable gloves), unlined, 300mm long minimum and at least 0.5mm thick (EN374-3)

Equipment

- Knapsack sprayer (e.g., Cooper Pegler Series 2000/Matabi/Bethoud or similar) – clean and in good working order. The sprayer should be capable of being carried on the back and capable of using interchangeable nozzles. If more than 1 person attends from the same organisation, then 1 sprayer will be sufficient between 2 people.
- Measuring jugs - 1 x 2 litre jug and 1 x small measuring jug/cylinder capable of accurately measuring quantities of less than 100ml

Other

- Calculator
- Pen/pencil and notepad
- Clean examples of product labels (optional)
- Also - Glasses if needed for reading/seeing the whiteboard and hearing aid if normally used
