

**What you need to bring**  
**Clearing Saw**

**Safety Equipment (PPE) for each person**

Personal First Aid Kit  
Safety helmet to EN397 incorporating ear defenders to EN352 and mesh visor / Perspex face shield  
Safety Glasses/Goggles to EN166 Standard  
Gloves  
Chainsaw/brushcutter trousers or strong work trousers  
Protective boots with toecap, good ankle support and good grip  
Hi Vis  
Non snag outer clothing appropriate to weather conditions

**Machine**

Clearing Saw with correct manufactures guard and safety features in accordance with AFAG 203  
(Machine: Learner – 1:1 optimum / 1:2 acceptable)  
Harness/Strap that came with the machine  
Cutting Blade in good condition  
Operators Instructions Book/Service Manual for the machine  
Fuel in appropriate container

**Operator's maintenance tool kit to include**

Combination spanner/screwdriver/torx driver  
Carburetor (small flat head) screwdriver  
Angle drive grease (if required)  
Clean, soft brush for air filter cleaning  
One other brush/cloths for general cleaning of the machine  
Feeler gauge for spark plug (metric)  
spark plug cleaning brush  
Work gloves for maintenance  
Inexpensive measuring calipers or a small ruler/tape  
Flat and round files c/w handle for correct blade sharpening along with blade setting tool (see the manufacturers handbook or the blade box for the correct file size for the machine).

Please Note: Instructors will not undertake training where trainees do not have the appropriate protective equipment and maintenance tools. All machines must be in good condition with all safety features in place and functioning.
