

### **What you need to bring**

#### **Pesticides - Various (Pesticide Plugs, Stem Injection & Minimal Calibration)**

Candidates should bring the following to the training and assessment:

#### **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)**

- Face Shield
- Coverall type 5/6 (suitable for pesticides use)
- Wellington boots
- Nitrile Gloves, unlined, 300mm long, min 0.5mm thick (EN374-3)

#### **Equipment**

##### **Pesticide Plugs:**

- Suitable drill (petrol powered or simple cordless drill)
- 13mm diameter wood bit with a depth stop welded on at 30-35mm depth (these can be bought from the same suppliers as ecoplugs)
- Hammer

##### **Operating Handheld Pesticide Injection Equipment (PA6INJ):**

- Own stem injection equipment with instruction manual

#### **Other**

##### **PP**

- Sufficient rounds of wood for learners

##### **PA6INJ**

- Calculator and writing materials
- Small measuring jug capable of accurate measuring up to 100ml

##### **MC**

- Several rings of timber to demonstrate painting pesticide onto bark (for on-site courses only)
- Applicator—i.e. bucket & brush or bottle with brush, etc.
- Other items maybe required depending on the product being applied.
- Clean examples of product labels for all 3 above (optional)
