What you need to bring Pesticides - Various (Pesticide Plugs, Stem Injection & Minimal Calibration)

Candidates should bring the following to the training and assessment:

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Face Shield
- Coverall type 5/6 (suitable for pesticides use)
- Wellington boots
- Nitrile Gloves, unlined, 300mm long, min 0.5mm thick (EN374-3)

Equipment

Pesticide Plugs:

- Suitable drill (petrol powered or simple cordless drill)
- 13mm diameter wood bit with a depth stop welded on at 30-35mm depth (these can be bought from the same suppliers as ecoplugs)
- Hammer

Operating Handheld Pesticide Injection Equipment (PA6INJ):

• Own stem injection equipment with instruction manual

Other

PP

• Sufficient rounds of wood for learners

PA6INJ

- Calculator and writing materials
- Small measuring jug capable of accurate measuring up to 100ml

MC

- Several rings of timber to demonstrate painting pesticide onto bark (for on-site courses only)
- Applicator—i.e. bucket & brush or bottle with brush, etc.
- Other items maybe required depending on the product being applied.
- Clean examples of product labels for all 3 above (optional)
